



## Major Mairehau High School evaluation question



This organisational diagram gives a visual representation of “Six key elements of Mairehau High School”. It displays the interconnectedness of key linkages within our school. All elements of the diagram are critically important to ensure support for student learning and promotion of student achievement. Clear alignment of school processes and operations to each of the elements ensures school improvement and successful outcomes for students.

The intention of this diagram is to emphasise that each of the key elements on the outer circle plays a critical role in supporting student outcomes and school improvement.

Our self review and subsequent evaluation processes need to be able to identify and improve processes to ensure positive outcomes for our students. Self review processes and documents are intended to be used as a source of information for our Board, Principal, Senior Lead Team, Learning Team Leaders, Deans and Teachers. The information in our self review documents may be used to establish goals, targets and expectations to support school improvement.

In terms of school self review and evaluation, we need to ask ourselves questions about linkages to the outside elements and how they contribute to student learning- presence, engagement, progress and achievement. To that end we ask ourselves the following major review question.

**How effectively does Mairehau High School's curriculum promote student learning- presence, engagement, progress and achievement?**
